Gozo lies in the heart of the Mediterranean as part of the Maltese Archipelago.

Its limestone cliffs rise up to an impressive 150 meters above sea level and drop down to 100 meters below. This creates a unique topography, offering a huge variety of world-class dive sites to choose from.

The Maltese archipelago is known as one of the best diving destinations in the Mediterranean. You can dive wrecks, caves and tunnels, shallow reefs, drop offs and archways, which are unforgettable due to a 20 – 40 meter visibility.

The marine life around the Maltese Islands is abundant with a variety of species with schools of barracudas,

jacks, small shy sea-horses and octopi. If you are lucky, moon-fish, eagle rays and even sharks can be seen.

Water temperatures of 25°C in the summer and 15°C in the winter allow all-year-round diving.

A typical trip involves staying in a luxury farmhouse with swimming pool and diving the best sites the islands have to offer.

Our experienced skipper will take you to two to three dives per day visiting the best wrecks, caves and drop offs to suit your experience.

Two days during the trip you can have a late start, staying out on the boat for a sunset meal and a night dive.
